

Please note if music is not playing in any part or area of the store, this is a sound system fault and not a Player issue.



Please follow the troubleshooting steps if you have no music in the entire store.

Check the amplifier has power and the volume is turned up - also check the volume on any remote Volume Controls.

Check the Player is showing a solid blue power light, ensure the audio lead is connected securely to the headphone port only (indicated by headphone icon) and ensure the SD card is present and fully seated in the slot.

Once this is done, re-connect the power lead and allow between 30 seconds and 3 minutes to boot and for music to be restored.

If still no music, reboot the player by pulling out the power lead from the back of the unit indicated with POWER label.

While the power lead is out, eject the SD card by pressing and releasing the card then pushing back in the ensure it clicks securely into place.

If there's still no music disconnect the audio lead from the headphone port on the front of the Player and connect headphones to test the Player's output - music should be heard straight through the headphones.

if music is present, re-connect the audio lead as the Player is working correctly and the sound system will need to be checked.

Please note if the music is playing but there is an intermittent fault, the output should also be checked directly with headphones.
